#### <u>Underlying assumptions:</u>

- Democracy is fundamental to the Australian and Victorian way of life. We enjoy its benefits & wish to keep it.
- It is the responsibility of all Australians, and most particularly our Parliamentary representatives, to act in a way which protects and enhances our democracy.
- Accountable government, where the rule of law, reason and perceived procedural fairness flourishes, strengthens democracy.
- The power and exercise of Executive government has developed to a point where direct accountability to Parliament and to the broader public interest is significantly reduced, and reducing.
- A renewed commitment to accountability by the government and prospective governments will be beneficial to:
  - o our democracy generally: the broad public interest,
  - o each government or prospective government itself,
  - o other nations for which we seek to be a positive model.
